Kajima has operated an environmental management system (EMS) since 1997. We established an integrated, company-wide system in fiscal 2003 and have since been expanding and reinforcing environmental activities with the participation of all employees. In December 2003, we obtained ISO 14001 certification.

Environmental Management Promotion Framework

Kajima has adopted an environmental management promotion framework by which business activities are divided into seven sectors, with leadership responsibility clearly vested in the Kajima divisions that supervise those sectors. The Environment Committee sets company-wide objectives, and evaluates and regulates environmental performance for each sector.

Kajima Group Environmental Representatives Conference

In February 2004, the first Kajima Group Environmental Representatives Conference was held for the purpose of promoting group environmental management. Twelve companies, most of which were construction affiliates, participated. The participants engaged actively in information exchange aimed at reducing environmental risk in business operations.



Introduction of the environmental management system at overseas construction projects

In 2003, the International Division introduced EMS at directly managed projects (overseas projects managed not by overseas subsidiaries, but directly by the International Division). Kajima's subsidiaries in Singapore and the United Kingdom had previously deployed the system, and its introduction at directly managed overseas projects represented expansion of Kajima's overseas environmental activities. The system is currently being utilized at three projects in Taiwan, and one each in Vietnam, Thailand, Indonesia, and Ethiopia. Kajima is undertaking a number of directly managed overseas projects in developing countries, and because waste disposal infrastructure in those countries is insufficient, Kajima engages in activities aimed at reducing waste of resources, materials, and equipment, as well as increasing reuse of temporary materials and reducing environmental impact in the vicinity of project sites.
