## Summary

This report presents and explains the policies and objectives that Kajima has established in its environmental activities.

### Period Covered by the Report

Fiscal 2004 (April 2004-March 2005)

### Principal Environmental Activities in Fiscal 2004

- More than 90% of design projects meet CASBEE criteria.
- The 66 energy-efficient designs proposed during the year on average exceeded government standards by more than 30%.
- CO2 emissions at the construction stage were cut by 9% from 1990 levels.
- Kajima becomes the first company in the construction industry to formulate Ecosystem Conservation Guidelines.
- The recycling rate of construction waste (excluding construction sludge) is raised to 92%.
